Top Ten Security Trends for 2009

- 1 Thieves and other criminals will continue to target laptops and mobile devices that hold valuable, identity-based information.

Mobile devices, including laptops, are becoming a larger number of users – 2008 saw the first year of laptop computers. Cybercriminals, recognizing the growing use of mobile platforms in an attempt to access the sensitive data on these platforms are more vulnerable to attack, particularly in public networks at hotels, airports, coffee shops and other public places.

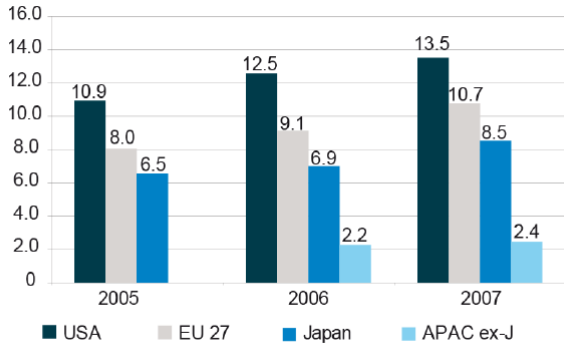

2005 – 2007 by world region



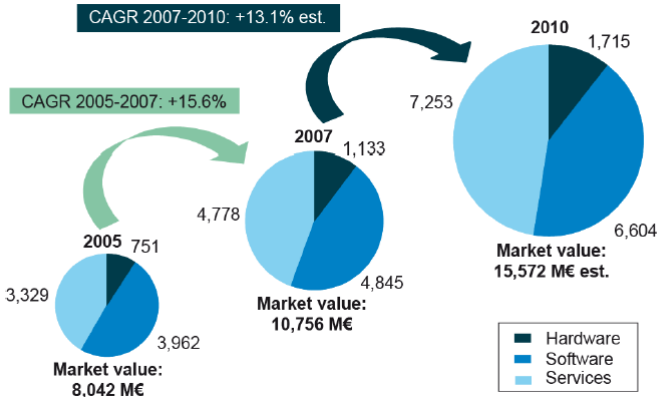

2005 – 2010 EU Forecast



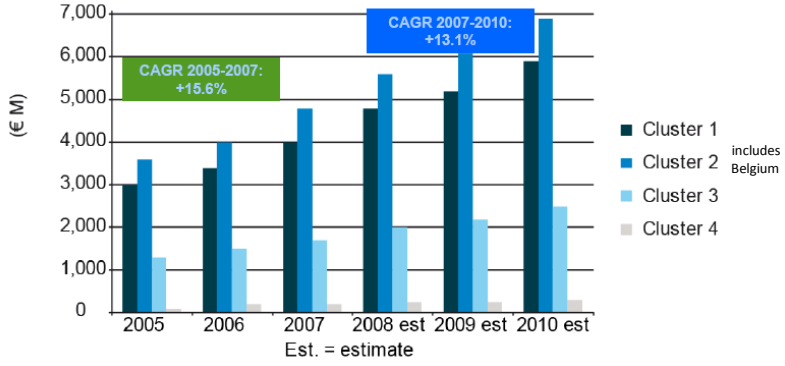

2005 – 2010 EU Forecast



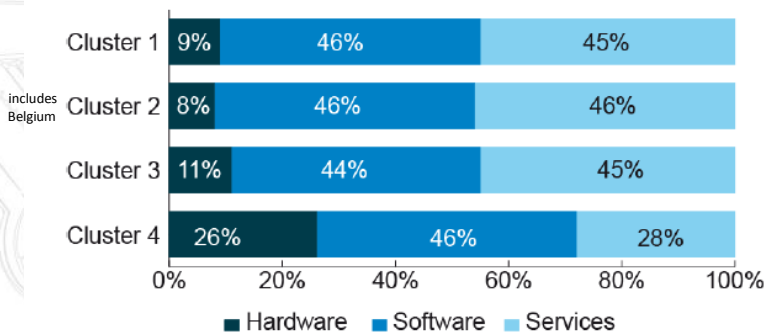

2007 Market Split HW, SW, Services per Cluster



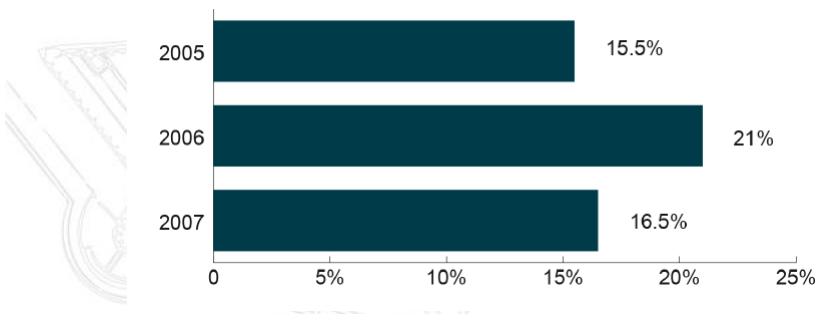

(combined market share)



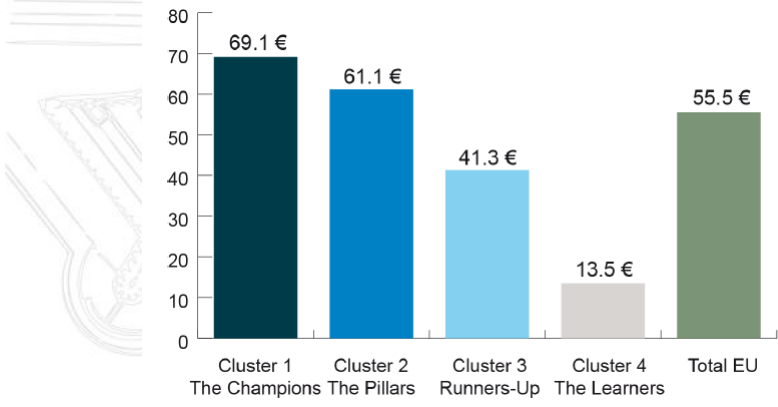
