1. Company Name (or Names of the companies involved if more than one)

3. Summary of your Product – Project – Innovation – Research Project, your innovative or groundbreaking project

4. Three or more reasons why this is innovative and better than perceived existing solutions (technically or otherwise).

5. Describe the basic architecture, the main functionalities, and some interesting specifications about the project.

6. List some of the potential threats that you could mediate with this solutions / solutions. Did it resolve major security concerns?

7. Can the product / project / solution be applied anywhere else, or is it a complete bespoke solution? What is the expected market (size) for the project?
