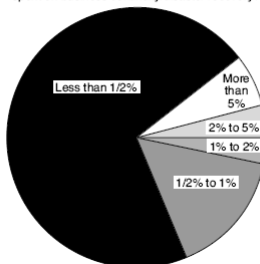


## Business Continuity Spending : some statistics \*

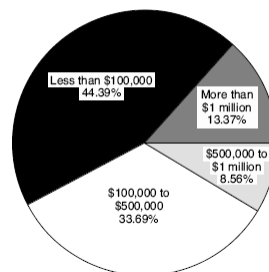
How are continuity costs funded?
